Key Responsibilities

- Manually loads, unloads and handles freight with the use of the following tools and equipment:
 - Stocker, Cherry Picker, Forklift, Pallet Jack and Hand Truck;
- Adheres to all safety guidelines which will include the use of all required safety equipment at all times;
- Assists in receiving freight by removing cargo from trucks and containers manually or using material handling;
- Accurately applies labels to the freight based on final destination;
- Assists in the deconsolidation of the cargo received by account or the intended location;
- Performs various manual labor functions such as hand-loading and stacking export containers or outbound trailers;
- Completes various warehouse maintenance tasks which may include but will not be limited to sweeping and clearing work areas of trash and debris and general aisle housekeeping;
- Additional tasks as they are assigned;
